Lodging: Camping is allowed on the property. The nearest city with lodging is Camp Wood, TX.

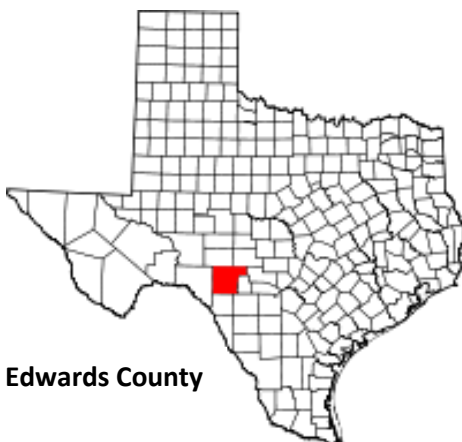
